The first **Caucasian Mathematics Conference (CMC I)** will be organized in Tbilisi, Georgia, on **September 5 and 6, 2014** under the auspices of the European Mathematical Society and the cooperation of the Armenian, Azerbaijan, Georgian, Iranian, Russian and Turkish Mathematical Societies.]

The scope of the Caucasian Mathematical Conference (CMC) is to bring together mathematicians from Caucasian and neighbouring countries annually in one of these countries. The CMC is partially supported by the EMS and is welcoming mathematicians from all over the world.

Thematic Sessions

Invited Talks: 3-4 talks every morning, 45 minutes+5-10 min. for discussions each

Afternoons Thematic Sessions: contributed talks from 15 hour (25 minutes+5 for discussions each). The list of sessions will be posted in the WEB after July 15. Participants still wishing to organize Thematic Sessions are encouraged to submit applications until **July 7, 2014** together with a preliminary list of at least 5 participants. Otherwise no constraints.

Registration deadline is **July 15** (with abstracts submission) and **September 1** (without abstract submission). For those, who will have not registered until **September 1**, we can't guarantee the conference kit.

The program of the conference will be announced on the web on August 1st and be updated on September 1st.

Conference fee: 20 USD or equivalent in GEL (Georgian Lari), or in Euro. Fee is due to pay on arrival, during registration on September 5 and 6.

Abstract submission: Register and send us abstract **before July 16, 2014**. After this deadline no abstracts will be accepted because the book of abstracts will be sent to print. We remind, that an abstract should be prepared in LaTeX format according to the standard template file (downloadable from the conference WEB) and should not exceed 1 page. Participants have to submit the LaTeX-source and PDF files of abstracts through WEB registration page or by e-mail to the addresses indicated above.

If you sent the title after July 15, but **before September 1**, your contribution might be included and printed in the program of the conference, but not in the book of abstracts.

Please **purchase a valid health insurance for Georgia**. If necessary, we can help you with a health insurance covering emergency treatment for 1 Euro a day per person. Please let us know if you would like us to send you information on this insurance prior to your departure from home.

Visa information: Visa affair is the easiest part of the travel. Citizens of many countries do not need an entrance visa for Georgia (citizens of EU countries, USA, Japan, Israel, Turkey, Canada, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova, Russia, Ukraine, etc.). Citizens of some countries, including citizens of Iran, can obtain a visa while crossing the border of Georgia at official checkpoints, including all airports of Georgia.
